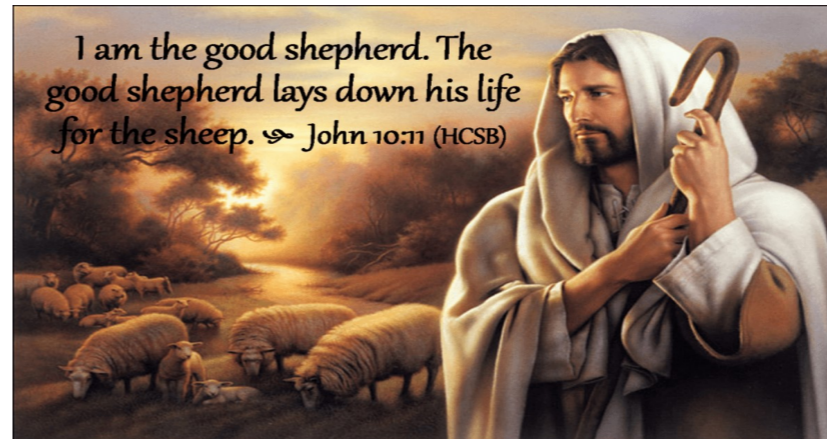

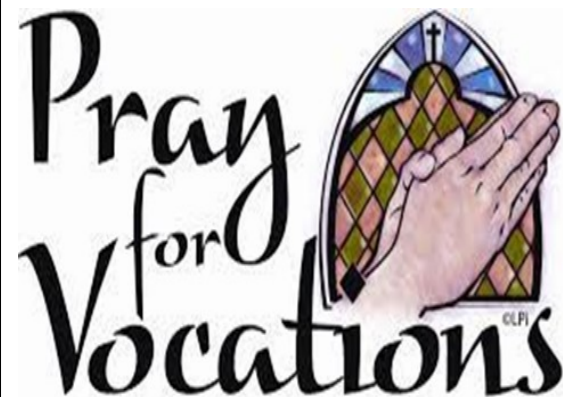
Prayer for the People of Ukraine
